MINUTES

NOVEMBER 4, 2024

The Preliminary Budget meeting was held at 5 PM in the Delmar Township garage due to the voting machines in the building for security purposes. Deven Martin, Garry Clark, Julie Sticklin, and Julia Heath went over the numbers and calculations to prepare for the budget passage at the December meeting.

The Workshop meeting was held at the same location at 6 PM. Joe Hastings spoke to the supervisors about the season winding down and finishing up road work and getting ready for the winter season. Joe gave them estimates for the well drilling and cost for the new building. Proceed with the well drilling for the new building the supervisors. There is going to be an open day for contractors to come in and ask questions pertaining to the mechanical end of the new building in November. Joe spoke about the work they are doing on West hill widening it and the compliments we have received about it. John is out mowing. They are patching potholes.
